44

45 Annex 1 holds information about previous consultations. I have repeated the same issues several
46 times and previous consultation documents can be assessed critically. Different units of the
47 European Commission already know something about my previous opinions.

48

49 Highlighting only some issues

50

51 This opinion does not handle all issues which are mentioned on the consultation document. I have
52 presented different issues to different units of the European Commission. Generally speaking many
53 proposals are already implemented and therefore I don't present all possible issues based on this
54 consultation.

55

**56 Consultation document is technologically neutral and does not mentioning any company
57 names**

58

59 It is fully understandable that the consultation document is technologically neutral. It is also fully
60 understandable that the consultation document does not mention specific company names.

61

62 European centre to prevent and counter child sexual abuse

63

64 INCEPTION IMPACT ASSESSMENT document mentions following issue.

65

66 The Commission also committed in the strategy to work towards the possible **creation of a**
67 **European centre** to prevent and counter child sexual abuse to enable a comprehensive and
68 effective EU response against child sexual abuse online and offline, based on a thorough
69 study and impact assessment.

70

71 I have mentioned several times European Union contact points (EUCP) when assessing information
72 technology solutions for the European Union.

73

74 NOTE: Naturally there can be global contact points for different information systems.

75

76 Therefore I present member state systems (MSS), member state contact points (MSCP) and
77 European Union contact point (EUCP).



79 EU-wide level?

80

81 I have noted several times that different member state systems (MSS) can interlinked in many ways.
82 This means that co-operation with European Union systems means a lot of work. This leads to the
83 question of a European Contact Point (EUCP) for different member state systems (MSS).

MSS = Member State System

88 There are 27 member states (European Union) at the moment. In reality there are unique situations
 89 with information systems in different member states. In some cases information systems can be
 90 implemented based on complex system-to-system connections. Complex system-to-system
 91 connections means a lot of work when there are changes in some systems.

92

93 Naturally there could be direct contacts between different member state systems (MSS) and
 94 European Union Contact Point (EUCP). This option ($\text{MSS} \leftrightarrow \text{EUCP}$) could mean very large
 95 number of different member state system. Based on 27 member state systems there could be
 96 hundreds of connections:

97

$$98 \quad 27 \times 10 = 270 \text{ MSS} \leftrightarrow 1 \text{ EUCP}$$

99

$$27 \times 20 = 540 \text{ MSS} \leftrightarrow 1 \text{ EUCP}$$

100

$$27 \times 30 = 810 \text{ MSS} \leftrightarrow 1 \text{ EUCP}$$



102 Here we can note that there can be hierarchy between different system ($\text{EU} \leftrightarrow \text{member states}$) and
 103 there can be member state contact points (MSCP). Then there can be some hierarchy between
 104 different systems. ($\text{EU} \leftrightarrow \text{EUCP} \leftrightarrow \text{MSCP} \leftrightarrow \text{MSS} \leftrightarrow \text{Member state}$). There are unique situations
 105 with member state systems in member states. Therefore member state contact points (MSCP) can
 106 reduce the complexity with European Union contact point (EUCP)

107

108 Based on those large numbers connecting ($\text{MSS} \leftrightarrow \text{EUCP}$) member state system I have to conclude
 109 that there should be member state contact points ($\text{EUCP} \leftrightarrow \text{MSCP} \leftrightarrow \text{MSS}$).


114 In the current situation, European Union member states (and some co-operation states) have their
115 own internal IDs for several information systems. Also, the members states organised as a
116 federation have their own internal problems with state-level IDs.
117

118 Based on those calculations there could be a lot of direct connections to the European contact point.
119 Number of those connections can be overwhelming. The situation between member states can vary
120 in many ways. So there can different and unique systems between member states.
121

122 On the other hand, there are some working examples of joined or federated EU-wide registers.
123 However, the amount of administration and needed legally binding agreements is considerable.
124

125 **Proposal : There could be one information system (member state contact point, MSCP)
126 on member state level.**

134 The solution can be, that member states have own Member State Contact Points (MSCP) and
 135 different state level systems are combined gradually. Then the member state system IDs can be used
 136 in the European Contact Point (EUCP).

138 Based on those large numbers connecting (MSS ↔ EUCP) member state system I have to conclude
 139 that there should be member state contact points (EUCP ↔ MSCP ↔ MSS).

140

141 Here we can note that there can be hierarchy between different system (EU ↔ member states) and
 142 there can be member state contact points (MSCP). Then there can be some hierarchy between
 143 different systems. (EU ↔ EUCP ↔ MSCP ↔ MSS ↔ Member state). There are unique situations
 144 with member state systems in member states. Therefore member state contact points (MSCP) can
 145 reduce the complexity with European Union contact point (EUCP).

146

147 **Proposal: Different member state systems could be consolidated based on limited**
 148 **number system-to-system connections.**

149

150 **Proposal: There could be some time frames for consolidating different member state**
 151 **systems (MSS) with member state contact points (MSCP).**

152

153 **Proposal: There could be some time frames for consolidating member state contact**
 154 **points (MSCP) with the European Union contact point (EUCP).**

155

156 **Proposal: One information system (member state contact point, MSCP) on member**
 157 **state level could handle system-to-system connections with the European Union level**
 158 **(European contact point).**

159

160 **Proposal: There could be some serious work for developing a standardised member**
161 **state contact point (MSCP).**

162

163 **Proposal: After developing a standardised member state contact point (MSCP)**
164 **different member states could consolidate their systems (MSS ↔ MSCP).**

165

166 **Proposal: European Union contact point (EUCP) and member state contact points**
167 **(MSCP) could then handle cooperation (EUCP ↔ MSCP ↔ MSS) on the European**
168 **Union level.**

169

170 Naturally we have to note that developing a standardised member state contact point (MSCP) means
171 more work. On the other hand a standardised member state contact point (MSCP) could handle
172 cooperation (EUCP ↔ MSCP ↔ MSS) based on unique situations in member states. Some member
173 states may have more systems than other member states. We have to note that there are different
174 systems based on several technological solutions.

175

176 **An example for cooperation: Web feeds (RSS and Atom)**



177

178

179

180 I have advocated usage of web feeds¹ on several previous opinion documents. Actually there are
181 two standards for web feeds: RSS^{2 3} and Atom^{4 5 6}.

182

183

184 **Proposal: Web feeds (RSS and/or Atom) could be advocated when developing different**
185 **informations systems.**

186

187

188 **Proposal: Web feeds (RSS and/or Atom) should be used extensively for providing (real-**
189 **time) information for different stakeholder(s) (communities).**

190

191

192 **Proposal: There can be different web feeds (RSS and/or Atom) for different**
193 **stakeholder(s) – having just one web feed (RSS and/or Atom) may not be a feasible**
194 **solution.**

195

196

197 **Proposal: Several web feeds (RSS and/or Atom) can be based on different viewpoints.**

198

199

200 It can be easier to create web feeds in different information systems since web feeds enable

196 connections without direct system-to-system connections.

197

198 It can be noted, that different back-office systems (with a wide variety of different technologies) can
199 implement RSS standards, and these RSS feeds can be used in the front-office systems. With this
200 kind solutions front-office systems don't need direct system-to-system communications with back-
201 office systems.

202

203

204 **Creation of different feeds, not just general web feeds (RSS and/or Atom)**

205

206 It is possible that there could be other feeds and not just RSS feeds.

207

208 **Proposal: There could be some assessment for creation of specific feeds for informing
209 issues related to this consultation.**

210

211 An example of a specific feed is the ClaimReview standard which is used for reporting fact-
212 checking reviews.

213

216 **NOTE: Creation of a specific standard (cf. ClaimReview) means cooperation between
217 several stakeholders which use and develop different information systems.**
