42 This opinion is bainly about information systems related the Personally Controlled Electronic
43 Health Records (PCEHR).



45 **General remarks: Also in Finland the¹ system for Personally Controlled Electronic Health
46 Records (PCEHR) is decentralised**

47

48 Here we can note that there can be a lot of separate information systems in some contexts. The
49 initial situation may mean totally independent systems without any connections.



53 IF information systems in some contexts are developed without clear guidelines there can be very
54 complex connections between different systems.



58 The opposite situation is naturally one centralised system with connections to several different

59 systems.



63 The problem with this option is possible outages which mean problems with other systems.



67 Next option may cooperation between some centralised ($S1 \leftrightarrow S2$) systems. Also this option may
68 have problems in actual usage.

70 Based on the problems with centralised system there is yet another solution: systems organised
71 based on different hierarchical solutions.



75 Then we have to note that there can complex networks for different systems.

79 Here we can note that the central system (CS) is in this context Personally Controlled Electronic
80 Health Records (PCEHR) system. Then there can be cooperation with different systems. Then there
81 can be different standards (format) for transmitting data between different systems.

82

83 **What this has to do with PCEHR (Information Commissioner Enforcement Powers)
84 Guidelines 2015 (draft)?**

85

86 Some general issues can be noted:

87

- 88 (i) There can be complex networks of information systems.
- 89 (ii) Personally Controlled Electronic Health Records (PCEHR) system can be a central
90 system for cooperation between different (sub)systems.
- 91 (iii) Decentralised nature for cooperation between systems can mean several connections.
- 92 (iv) All (private) information should be handled carefully in all (sub)systems.

93

94 **Some solutions based on previously mentioned problems?**

95

96 Here we can note that we are dealing with legislative text (PCEHR (Information Commissioner
97 Enforcement Powers) Guidelines 2015 (draft))

98

99 Based on results of previous consultation we can note that complex legislative text can be presented
100 with very readable forms and/or system interfaces.

101

102 **Proposal: The final legal text (PCEHR (Information Commissioner Enforcement
103 Powers) Guidelines 2015) could be presented with more readable forms and/or system
104 interfaces.**



106 Too often we give complicated legal texts (legalese) for general usage – the same issues can be
107 presented as more readable texts.

109 **Several readable forms and/or system interfaces**

113 Here we can note one system can have several interfaces – we can also note that different paper-
114 based additions to a system should be very easy.



116 **Proposal: There could be a consultation about the simple interfaces and simple (legal)
117 forms.**

119 **Need for more technical consultations?**

123 I have proposed in some cases more technically oriented consultations. Also I have proposed
 124 different questionnaires for members on different national IT expert associations.

125

126 **Proposal: There could be more technically oriented consultations based on the**
 127 **results of this consultation.**

128

129 In European Union context ACER (The Agency for the Cooperation of Energy Regulators) has
130 organised several technically oriented consultations for assessing different issues in different ACER
131 systems – check Annex 1.

132

133 **Proposal: Information of different technically oriented consultations could be sent to**
134 **different IT expert associations.**

135

136 Naturally there should be only a limited number of technical consultations for different IT expert
137 associations.



139 **Final remarks**

140

141 Naturally we have to note the importance of privacy in PCEHR system(s) and with different
142 cooperative systems.

146 Based on previous opinions (check Annex 1) I have presented the previous figure. Generally
147 speaking different ICT experts try to understand a specific domain. Generally speaking different
148 domain experts try to understand ICT. There can be several several mismatches between ICT
149 experts and domain experts.

151 Based on the previous proposals of PCEHR (Information Commissioner Enforcement Powers)
152 Guidelines 2015 could be presented to ICT experts and domain experts. There could be more
153 understanding between different experts when different issues are carefully and presented with
154 more clarity.
